# 1137 To report any new Highways Issues.

- 1137.1 <u>Action:</u> Passing bays and the state of the road in general in Cursey Lane. The clerk wrote to Highways 21/1/22 requesting urgent attention to this long outstanding issue.
- 1137.2 <u>Action:</u> The clerk will request urgent attention to the long outstanding problem of flooding at the entrance to Church Lane, Elmstone Hardwicke. Councillor Awford confirmed that cameras will be used in order to check the gullies and this was arranged for the 28/11/18.
- 1137.3 <u>Action:</u> The clerk will request urgent attention to the long outstanding problem of the issue of flooding along Lowdillo Lane with Highways.
- 1137.4 <u>Action:</u> The clerk will inform Highways of the serious cracking along roads within the parish that require urgent infilling before the onset of winter. This particularly applies to the full length of Copse Green Lane.

#### 1138 To discuss Community Approaches to Road Safety

- Following establishment of the Road Safety Partnership alongside Gloucestershire County Council creating a joint road safety fund to tackle persistent speeding, they have launched a £600,000 Community Speed Watch Safety Fund. The fund will provide communities with the tools they need to combat speeding in their area.signage. They will be also helping community groups by funding speed surveys, on site meetings with road safety officers and providing wheelie bin signage.
- 1138.2 <u>It was agreed that</u> the Councillor Garside on behalf of the Parish Council should apply seeking support for Speed Surveys, Wheelie Bin Stickers and Mobile Vehicle activated signs. We would also that need the support of the local County Councillor. Applications close on the 31/1/23.

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# 1139 To discuss old brick bridge on the bridleway from Cursey lane to Copse Green Farm, showing signs of wear.

1139.1 Councillor Lewis met with the Highways Manager who agreed that repairs are required.

# 1140 To discuss Pumping Station, Elmstone Hardwicke.

- 1140.1 A planning application was submitted to TBC in respect of land off the A38 at Coombe Hill for 150 dwellings. Application was refused but later approved under appeal by the Planning Inspector and number of properties was reduced to 98 properties.
- 1140.2 As the land does not fall within Elmstone Hardwicke Parish, we did not receive information regarding the plan. However, it has come to light that Severn Trent intend to link up pipework by coming across the fields to the pumping station at The Green which does not have capacity for an extra 98 houses as confirmed by contractors who service the pumping station. Already after heavy rain residents of The Green experience water coming back up their toilets, and flooding over the road.
- 1140.3 Emails have been sent to Severn Trent by Councillor Phil Awford and the office of Laurence Robertson. All to no avail.
- 1140.4 It has become apparent that the Appeal Decision did state that Planning Approval was required for a number of constraints including Foul and Service Water Drainage.
- The Parish Council will therefore request that TBC Planning Department be made aware of the issues with the current pumping station and that TBC include Elmstone Hardwicke Parish Council in any planning applications made in respect of Foul and Service Water Drainage.
